A Biblical Plan for Our Finances

The concept of **tithing** has been the method of financially supporting the church and her ministries since the early Church. **Tithing** means returning **10%** of one's income to the church they attend. Contributions to missions & other groups are considered **offerings** or **commitments** – donations apart from the 10% tithe.

If you don't tithe, you're encouraged to practice the Biblical principle for the next 3 months. **Commit** the **First 10%** of your income to the storehouse. **Then** for **90 days** return that portion to the church. After that **90 day period**, if it has created a financial crisis or you did not receive a blessing, your money will be returned.

Requirement: *“Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse...”*

Response: *“and test me now in this”*

Reward: *“I will open for you the windows of heaven, and pour out for you a blessing until it overflows. **Malachi 3:10***
